- Divide the syllabus according to the research areas of the departments so that different groups of people can start working together to improve research in different domains
- M.Tech programmes syllabus to be in lieu with contemporary requirements.

Prof. P.S. Rao, President, Gayatri Vidya Parishad Advised to

- > Send the soft copies of the report to all the members so that if they attend online they can give informed suggestions after seeing the report.
- Placement record to be improved.
- Asked for separate proposal to be put up for additional space, indoor games facility before the finance committee.

- > Focus on qualitative research not mere numbers.
- Research encouragement to be given
- Start M.Tech programs to improve the research
- Encourage faculty to forge association with the local industry and attend their problems. This may culminate to more consultancy.
- > Startups to be promoted by students & Faculty.
- Innovation ecosystem to be promoted on campus.
- Local Industry problems may be addressed and delivered as live projects.

- Introduce four years UG Programme in Data Science and other emerging areas.
- Discussed the introduction of 4 year Degree Programmes and 1 Year PG programme as per National Education Policy and APSCHE guidelines.

Prof. P. Rajaganapati, Member, Gayatri Vidya Parishad

Programmes on ethical and moral values to be organized to inculcate ethics in students by integrating them in curriculum wherever possible.

Prof. S. Rajani, Principal has added that the AICTE is conducting online FDPs on teaching Universal Human Values and Ethics and Faculty are being nominated to attend these programmes.

The Principal seeks approval from the Governing Body for the following proposals

- > Sanction of posts for different programs as the programs are accredited and the faculty student ratio has to be maintained at a higher value of 1:15.
- Sanction of posts for B.Voc. Courses in Telecommunication and Mobile Communication.
- To fill vacancies that have arisen due to attrition in different programs of MCA, MSc (Organic Chemistry), MSc (Computer Science), MHRM, BSc and BBA.
- Additional built up area for establishing new labs to cater to the need of the PG programs in Engineering and Technology.
- ➤ To start additional sections in B.Tech and M.Tech in new and emerging areas.
- To create an Indoor sports facility at Dwarakanagar campus.
